

**DOCUMENT #17: Mr. M. Kennis**  
**(addressed to Philip Savage)**

March 28, 1992

Dear Mr. Philip Savage:

I contacted you last year, in March 1991, in order for you to intervene on behalf of my brother-in-law, Mr. M. Benard.

He was then suffering from an initial prostatic cancer that has turned into a terminal bone cancer. As a matter of fact, official medicine had already rendered its verdict: Nothing could be done and, at best, he only had six months to live.

I never heard of you before, but after I saw you on TV, I wrote to you as our last ultimate recourse. Two days later, I received a phone call from one of your collaborators who informed us that our case will be taken into consideration due to the extremely grave condition of the patient. After we obtained all the information we needed, we agreed to send you a photograph of the patient, as well as a very large sum of money that we were eager to donate for your cause in full acknowledgment of it and in total agreement.

Since that time, we have always kept in touch by phone and your collaborator kept us constantly informed from the very moment you had started to "remote-heal" the patient.

From that very time, we have checked on the miraculous improvement of the patient. As a matter of fact, he used to almost always be in bed and suffered beyond martyrdom. But progressively, he started walking again. He then started taking his dog for walks again and even started to drive himself, and alone, his own car on fairly long trips. These are, of course, things that he was unable to perform for a long time.

We were utterly bewildered and so were the doctors. Therefore, they spoke of "absolutely unexpected stabiliza-

tion" of the cancer and started even to reduce the morphine doses since the patient was no longer suffering. Their amazement was so extreme that doctors even mentioned a case of true cancer regression.

I would like to add that you were more than eager to be permanently informed of the healing condition of our patient and very especially demanding that we continue to send all of the medical examinations and controls that we were ordered to acquire on his behalf. You have never accepted to interfere in the medical field and of course, you have never asked us to change or to interrupt the medical cares.

I was constantly in touch with you since you were kind enough to give me your address and phone number. All that demonstrates how much you did care about us and the extreme seriousness of our mutual relationship.

Unfortunately, since September, I was unable to get hold of you, until the political police tried to force us into pressing charges against you for "Practicing Medicine without a licence." Of course, we refused to do so. We know that you are not a dishonest person. You are actually a "Wonderful" being and I, hereby, express again my absolute confidence in you. And in order to demonstrate all my trust, I beg you to further the "healing" that you have already accomplished upon my brother-in-law. In fact, due to this police operation that has interrupted the treatment, a relapse did occur, forcing us to seek new treatment.

I hope your persecutions come soon and fortunately to a close.
